We have once again been able to increase the value of programming delivered to the communities and stakeholders that we serve.

**A few project highlights include:**

- Urgent Action Funded **Stretched Project** – we supported the National Association of Nigerian Students (NANS) in conducting a thorough analysis of a sexual harassment case involving a Professor of English Studies at the University of Lagos, using a feminist lens and articulating the experiences of sexual violations experienced by female students.
- We also carried out a campaign on making SDG 5 count by supporting Gender Budgeting in African countries at the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women UN CSW 62. We had up to 62 attendees stand up with us to demand for this novel change in African countries economic plan and policies.

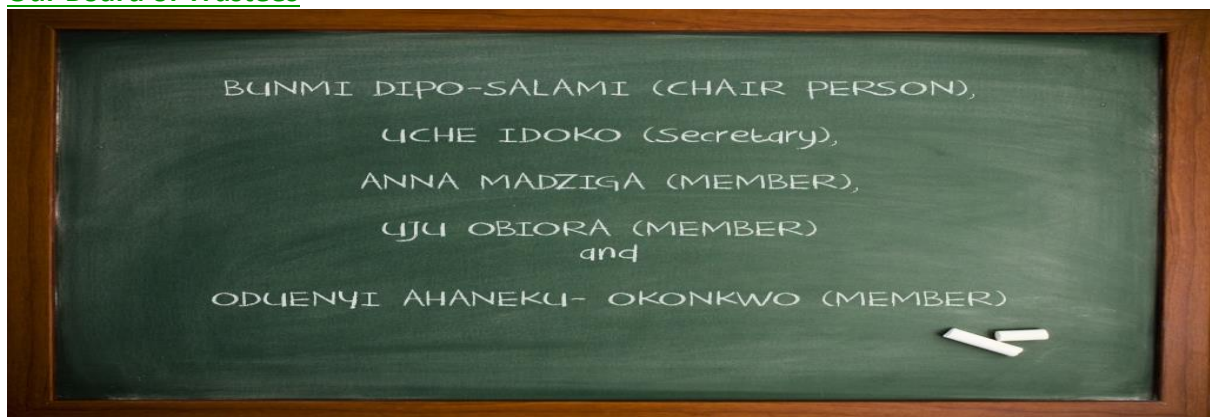
